Dear Parents and Carers,

Thank you so much for completing the OFSTED style questionnaire—we know that it was a bit lengthy but we wanted to gather your views on the key elements of our school. A big “thank you” for the many, many lovely and positive comments about the changes that we have made, they are very much appreciated by us all!

The following results are based on the responses of 33 families. Here is what you said...

**100% said that their child is happy at school**

100% said that their child feels safe at school

**100% said that their child makes good progress**

100% said that their child is well looked after

**88% said that their child is taught well**

70% said that their child receives appropriate homework

**100% said that the school is well led and managed**

100% said that the school responds well to any concerns that are raised

**88% said that behaviour is good**

We asked you for your suggestions for further improvements and these are the things that you said....

- **Improvements to the building, the toilets, perimeter hedge**

*We are waiting for further surveys and hope to have news later this term. The hedge has been cut right back to give full access to the pavement.*

- **More use of drama**

- **More inter-school participation in team sports and further links with other schools and the local community**


- **Continue with the progressive thinking**

-  • **Improved nursery provision**  
 *We have revised our staffing structure and Mr. Chruszcz and Mrs. Diamond are now teaching our nursery classes with the support of Miss Simpson*
-  • **Additional Teaching Assistants / extra support for English and maths, 1-1 support for children who need it**  
 *We have appointed 4 new Teaching Assistants so that each teacher has support every morning during their English and maths lessons. This initiative is solely to support the teaching and learning and to further raise standards.*
-  • **Several people commented on maths provision and the further raising of results. There was a suggestion of an online maths resource/ 5 minute daily maths challenges**  
 *Maths is the main focus on our 2016/17 School Development Plan. Please see the attached letter for details of our plans to raise attainment further.*
-  • **Greater emphasis on good attendance, punctuality, behaviour and correct uniform**  
 *We will be making these our priority this year.*
-  • **Comments about the website including more information such as lists of topics to be studied and suggested reading lists.**
-  • **Parents to be consulted about friendship groups**
-  • **Fewer parent events**
-  • **Cycling proficiency courses**
-  • **More multicultural events**
-  • **Better use of technology**
-  • **More school visits including local visits in and around Cheadle**
-  • **More information about progress**
-  • **The involvement of our Sports Crew in Sport and Talent Week**  
 *A great idea—we just hadn't thought of it! We will do it this year!*
-  • **Reading books changed more frequently**
-  • **More notice and reminders about events**  
 *We will do our best! This year, we have given more detail on our annual diary such as dates and times which we hope will help.*





-  • **Welcome meetings to be held at Transition**  
 *This year, we have planned meetings to take place just before Transition. We have also introduced weekly transition visits to help children and staff to get to know each other.*
-  • **Some parents would like to see the half termly completed test papers and copies of the mental maths tests.**  
 *Test papers will be sent home once they have been marked and next steps identified for teaching. We will look into putting mental maths test information on the website.*
